General Safety Rules for Galveston County 4-H Horse Shows

- 1. Horses should be **kept at a walk** except in the warm-up area and show rings
- 2. Always have **control** of **your horse** Uncontrollable horses will be asked to **leave the ring**
- Properly fit and adjust your tack before entering arena If you need to adjust tack after entering the arena, go to the center of the arena
- 4. Keep the **alleys**, the **entrance gates**, and the **exit gates** CLEAR **at all times** Exhibitors, parents, and trainers **will be asked** to leave

Exhibitors, parents, and trainers will be asked to leave area

- 5. **Be aware** of other riders at all times, **avoid bumping** into each other
- When passing a horse in the arena, pass towards the center/inside of arena Do NOT pass along the rail

- Keep a minimum of at least one horse length away from other horses
 Try to keep 2-3 horse lengths away from all other horses
- Horses that are known to kick should have a red ribbon tied in their tail Give horses with red ribbons in their tails more room
- 9. Tie your horse using a *quick-release* knot Do NOT tie your horse with a bit or stud chain
- 10. Per Galveston County Park regulations, dogs must be kept confined on leashes within County-owned park facilities. No animals other than services animals are allowed within County park community buildings. Owners will be asked to remove any dogs deemed as a hazard by show management.
- 11. **Parents** must be in **direct physical control** of small children at all times.
