

- 2. Update or create a profile

Use an email you check regularly! This is the email the Extension Office will use to send newsletters, upcoming events and all other important information.

<u>Returning Members</u> - Log in using the same email and password you used last year. **Do not create a new profile**. You can change your email once logged on.

New Members – you must create a new profile.

3. Enrollment Deadline and Fees

If you enroll before October 31, 2023 your participation fee is only \$25 per member.

After October 31, 2023, the fee will increase to \$30 per member, so sign up ASAP!

SWINE Tags for 2024 Spring Shows

Deadline: September 28, 2023, Online (LATE Deadline: October 31, 2023)

Good for validation on November 27

- For MARKET SWINE attending spring major shows
- For BREEDING SWINE attending spring shows, check show rules to see if validation is required.

HEIFER Orders for 2024 Spring Shows LATE Deadline: October 8, 2023 Online

Good for validation on October 26

 For REGISTERED BREEDING HEIFERS attending spring shows

NEW: All Major Show heifers will now be tagged. Previously validated heifers will **NOT** be required to get tagged unless they have changed ownership or breed.

SHEEP/GOAT Tags for 2024 Spring Shows LATE Deadline: October 8, 2023 Online

Good for validations on October 25

- For SHEEP/GOAT attending spring major shows
 - ✓ Market Sheep/Goat
 - ✓ Registered Breeding Sheep/Goat
 - ✓ Commercial/Wether Dam/Doe

NEW: Sheep/goats validated during June 2023 **WILL BE ELIGIBLE** for 2024 Spring Major Shows. Market sheep/goats validated for the 2023 State Fair will carryover for 2024 Spring Major Shows. The validated animal MUST stay in the care of the exhibitor who validated it. If the exhibitor chooses to sell the project to a new exhibitor, the new exhibitor **MUST REVALIDATE** the project within the next validation period (October 2023).

Smokey Bear Poster Contest

Texas A&M Forest Service presents Smokey Bear **Poster Contest for Texas Students**

Students from Kindergarten through 12th grade are invited to participate in a Smokey Bear Poster contest to help us celebrate his 80th birthday in 2024. Students will have the opportunity to demonstrate their understanding of wildfire prevention through their original artwork of Smokey Bear. Independent school districts, homeschools, youth programs, scout groups, and other informal education or youth organizations may submit entries from school-aged participants.

Smokey Bear is nationally recognized as the symbol for wildfire prevention. The original Smokey Bear appeared in 1944. His message of "Only you can prevent wildfires!" encourages personal responsibility for wildfire prevention since nine out of ten wildfires are caused by people. Smokey Bear uses five rules to teach children and adults to be careful with campfires, outdoor debris burning, and matches.

Texas communities have been impacted by wildfires every year. People and their activities account for 90% of wildfires in Texas with the most common preventable cause being careless debris burning. Other causes include welding and other equipment use, vehicles, discarding smoking materials, and arson. Entries should feature wildfire prevention for issues seen in Texas.

The Poster Contest will be divided into six divisions:

- 1. Kindergarten through 2nd grade
- 2. 3rd through 5th grade
- 3. 6th through 8th grade
- 4. 9th through 12th grade
- 5. Special education 6. Computer-assisted design (CAD)

Two winners will be chosen from each division with each winner earning a spot in the 2024 Smokey Bear 80th Birthday Calendar plus more!

Contest is open to 6 - 12th Graders. Youth must grow a vegetable during September - December in one of the following: Container, Raised Bed, or Row Garden.


