Enrollment Instructions:

- 1. Visit https://v2.4honline.com/
- 2. Update or create a profile

Use an email you check regularly! This is the email the Extension Office will use to send newsletters, upcoming events and all other important information.

<u>Returning Members</u> - Log in using the same email and password you used last year. **Do not create a new profile**. You can change your email once logged on.

New Members - you must create a new profile.

3. Enrollment Deadline and Fees

If you enroll before October 31, 2023 your participation fee is only \$25 per member.

After October 31, 2023, the fee will increase to \$30 per member, so sign up ASAP!

New - Clover Kids are now \$10 per child.



QUALITY COUNTS REQUIREMENTS FOR MAJOR SHOW ENTRIES

Required for all youth:

- 1.Exhibiting livestock
- 2. Submitting calf scramble applications

Visit <u>Quality Counts</u> website for instructions on how to take the test.

***Youth who took Quality Counts test <u>last year</u> do not have to retake the test **EXCEPT** for any child who

- entered 6th grade for the 2023-2024 school year
- entered 9th grade for the 2023-2024 school year

MAJOR SHOW ENTRY NIGHT

This applies to 4-H'ers entering 2024 Major Shows:

- ✓ Livestock & Poultry Projects
- ✓ Calf Scrambles (participants AND applicants)
- Team and Individual contests (Coaches ONLY)

Participants must attend this mandatory Major Show Entry Night at Galveston County Extension Office:

- November 7, 2023 from 4:30 6:30 PM
- November 13, 2023 from 4:30 6:30 PM

Fort Worth Stock Show entries must be submitted by November 7, 2023. No exceptions!

Each family must sign up to attend a specific time slot to submit entries. Time slots are limited in order to manage and expedite the entry process.

SIGN UP HERE ASAP for Nov. 7 or Nov. 13

Prior to dates above, contact Leah Stiles if you have conflicts (281-309-5058 or leah.stiles@ag.tamu.edu).

A \$25 LATE fee will be charged to any entries submitted after *Nov.* 13!

BEFORE ENTRY NIGHT

- 1. Pass Quality Counts
- 2. Complete 4-H Enrollment online via 4-H Online
- 3. Complete entry forms
 - Download from <u>county webpage</u> (they will be uploaded as they become available)
 - DO NOT sign Houston Livestock Show forms prior to entry night

BRING WITH YOU TO ENTRY NIGHT

- 1. Completed entry forms
- 2. Parent and youth must be present to sign
 - EXCEPTION: for TEAM contests, ONLY the coach needs to attend entry night, unless otherwise stated on entry form.
- 3. **Drivers License** (parents)
- 4. Social Security (youth)
- 5. **Payment** (cash, check, or with credit card via Square reader for additional processing fee)

Major Show entry night DOES NOT apply to Galveston Fair entries or youth showing under FFA.

MAJOR SHOW CALF SCRAMBLES

Calf scrambles are a great opportunity for youth to receive funds to help them purchase an animal project. Families are then financially responsible for the nutrition, housing, and grooming program. Things to consider before scrambling:

- Is family financially able to purchase, house, and feed an animal project?
- Do you have suitable facilities to raise animal?
- Would you devote the necessary time and attention?
- Would you be able to spend the necessary time away from school to care for and exhibit the project?

This year's 4-H Food Show theme is: "Cooking Through the Decades."


Take a trip back in time and explore different dishes that were popular in years past!


