

DOG VALIDATION

Deadline: January 10, 2024

Where: Due on 4-H Online

Texas 4-H Dog Show will be held July 11-13, 2024. To be eligible, dogs must be validated through 4-H Connect by January 10, 2024.

There is no fee for validation, just fill out the information and upload two pictures. Any mixed breed or purebred dog over six months old by July 12, 2023 is eligible. Here is a YouTube tutorial on how to validate your dog.
