Ag Product Identification

This contest provides youth the ability to further their knowledge and skills when evaluating agricultural products grown in Texas. For the Agriculture Product Identification contest, 20 Texas agricultural products are selected and exhibited at separate stations. Click <u>here</u> for Ag ID information video.

Educational Presentation & Public Speaking

Showcase your speaking skills! <u>Educational presentations</u> allow you to give a speech about a topic, using props and visual aids. <u>Public speaking</u> is an opportunity to share your thoughts and ideas about various topics in a persuasive speech. Both contests give you a limited time to present your topic, then answer judges' questions.

Talent Showcase

With up to nine 4-H members, or individually, you can "share-thefun" in one of seven categories, including vocal, musical/ instrumental, poetry/prose, and more! Click <u>here</u> for more info.

Consumer Decision Making

Use skills of consumer observation and comparison to make a fact-based purchases, then defend purchase decisions to a panel of judges. Teams will receive one key ingredient for an assigned dish category and then must create a dish using that ingredient plus "purchased" items from the contest "grocery store." You must register <u>here</u> AND let the Galveston County Extension Office know you are competing <u>at least 3</u> weeks before each show.





DOG VALIDATION

Deadline: January 10, 2024

Where: <u>4-H Online</u>

Texas 4-H Dog Show will be held July 11-13, 2024. To be eligible, dogs must be validated through 4-H Online by January 10, 2024.

There is no fee for validation, just fill out the information and upload two pictures. Any mixed breed or purebred dog over six months old by July 12, 2023 is eligible. Here is a <u>YouTube tutorial</u> on how to validate your dog.
