- d. What other projects and activities do you participate in?
- e. How 4-H has helped you become a better leader and citizen and what you have learned through your community service and leadership activities?
- f. How being a 4-H member has helped you set goals and develop new interests, and if 4-H has influenced your future plans or career goals?

3. Leadership Experiences

- a. What activity did you participate in?
- b. What was your leadership role (Elected, Appointed, Volunteer)?
- c. What level did you participate (Club, County, District, State, National, International)?
- d. What were your responsibilities and duties?
- e. How many people were reached or taught?
- f. How many hours did you put in the activity?
- g. Did the activity meet one of your goals?

4. Community Service and Citizenship
